

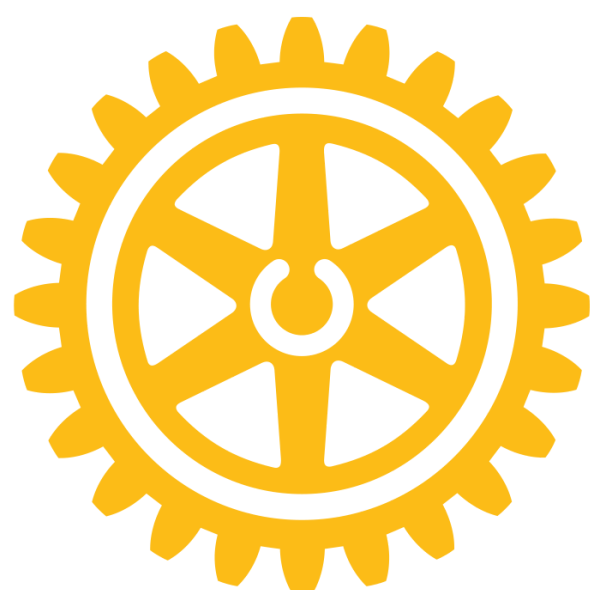
BEING AN LGBT+ ALLY

An LGBT+ Ally is a Straight (heterosexual) advocate for LGBT inclusion – a supporter, a friend, a person who wants to see change and is prepared to help bring it about.

THE ROLE OF AN ALLY

1. Make time to **talk** to members of the LGBT+ community about their experiences.
2. **Be yourself**, ask yourself how you would like to be treated in your club, in the community.
3. **Be visible**, make clear public statements about the importance of LGBT equality to you and your club. Use the rainbow heart on your club materials.
4. **Call out** negative behaviours and words that are not inclusive.
5. **Put words into practice**, attend LGBT+ inclusion events and bring your fellow club members.
6. **Join** the LGBT Rotarians and Friends Fellowship.
